Tony Sayegh is a political news analyst, campaign management consultant, and government affairs professional. He has also dedicated much of his time to public and community service and has more than a decade of managerial experience in business, marketing and operations.

Tony attended The George Washington University in Washington D.C., where he received both a B.A in Political Science and Master of Public Administration. As an undergraduate, he was elected Executive Vice President of the Student Association and received a Presidential Administrative Fellowship to continue his graduate studies. Tony worked in the University Office of Alumni Relations and served as a speechwriter for the University President and several Deans. After graduating, he was selected to sit on the University Board of Trustees. He held a seat on the board from 2003-2007, and served on The Medical Center, Academic Affairs and Student Affairs committees.

In Washington, Tony worked in the legislative office of Congresswoman Susan Molinari (R-NY) and served on the staff of former HUD Secretary Jack Kemp's 1996 campaign for Vice President of the United States. His political work also included press related positions during both the 1996 & 2000 Republican conventions. He also served as a Legislative Fellow in Governor Pataki's Office of Federal Affairs. Tony then joined Biznews24, a streaming media communications company, as the producer of WashingtonWired, a political news program that was among the first on the Internet.

In 2002, Tony ran unsuccessfully for the NY State Assembly in the 88th district., but went onto have one of the strongest fundraising efforts for challengers in that cycle. Tony was first elected to public office at the age of 26. He served as a Trustee and Deputy Mayor of the Village of Tuckahoe from 2003-2007. Tony was the liaison to the Police and Fire Departments, as well as the Village Court, Community Center, Senior Citizens and Intergovernmental Affairs.

From 2005-2008, Tony managed many campaigns at the state, county and local levels. In 2008, Tony started Elias Kemp Consulting, which advises candidates and organizations on developing grassroots and issues campaigns and offers political management and communications consulting.

In 2009, Tony began appearing as a regular guest on the FOX News Network. He also is frequently on the FOX Business Channel and is a weekly contributor to FOX'S on-line programming at LIVE.FOXNEWS.COM, and writes opinion pieces for the FOXNEWS.COM Opinion Page.

In 2011, Tony was named National Political Correspondent for Talk Radio News Service, based in Washington D.C. That same year, Tony became the Republican analyst at News12 Westchester, Cabelvision's news affiliate that covers Westchester and the Hudson Valley of New York.

Tony lives in Eastchester, New York with his wife Maria and their four children. They are parishioners of St. Joseph's Church in Bronxville.
